It is the responsibility of the person hiring the bouncy castle to ensure all possible steps are taken to avoid injury or damage to the inflatable and that the following rules and guidelines are adhered to.

- A responsible adult must supervise the Bouncy Castle AT ALL TIMES
- CLIMBING, HANGING ON OR SITTING ON WALLS IS DANGEROUS AND MUST NOT BE ALLOWED
- This bouncy castle is suitable for **CHILDREN ONLY** and must not be used by adults under any circumstances.
- Shoes <u>MUST BE REMOVED</u> before using the castle. We recommend keeping socks on.
- STRICTLY NO FOOD OR DRINK should be taken on or near the bouncy castle.
- The Bouncy Castle <u>MUST NOT</u> be used until fully inflated and confirmed ready to use by a qualified person.
- All shoes, glasses, jewellery and badges <u>MUST BE REMOVED</u> before using the Bouncy Castle. Check pockets for anything loose or sharp also.
- <u>STRICTLY NO</u> face paint, party poppers, coloured streamers, confetti cannons or silly string to be used on or near the Bouncy Castle.
- NO SMOKING OR BBQ'S on or near the Bouncy Castle
- Always ensure that the Bouncy Castle is not overcrowded, and limit numbers according to the age and size of Children using it. Try to avoid large and small Children from using it at the same time.
- You must ensure children are not pushing, colliding, fighting or behaving in a manner likely to cause injury or distress to other users.
- Do not allow anyone to bounce on the front safety step as a Child could easily bounce off the inflatable and get hurt. The step is there to assist users in getting on or off!
- The Bouncy Castle <u>MUST NOT</u> be used by anyone with back or neck problems or anyone who is feeling unwell.
- YOU MUST keep pets away from the Bouncy Castle at all times.
- An area of 6 feet (2 metres) around the castle <u>MUST</u> be kept clear at all times
- Our Bouncy Castles are fitted with rain covers which offer shelter from light showers however if rain becomes any heavier than a light shower the Bouncy Castle <u>MUST BE TURNED OFF</u> and the blower and extension must be taken in out of the rain. Any wetness including bubbling (which is normal) can be dried with a towel when rain has stopped.
- In the unlikely event that a blower stops working, please ensure all users get off the Bouncy Castle <u>IMMEDIATELY</u>
